

Child's Patchwork Jacket

Homework and Materials

For you to practice some of the techniques used in making this jacket please bring the following materials and do the following homework:

Materials

Yarn- Worsted weight yarn makes a size 4 jacket. Bring as many colors as you want. I recommend at least 6-7 colors. From my experience, I suggest you bring both the yarn and the colors you really like. The sample you create can serve as a model for further work or be the beginning of your Horst Schulz inspired jacket.

Needles- Bring compatible sized needles for your yarn. Straight, circular or double-pointed. I used a size 9.

Accessories- Scissors, measuring tape, pencil, paper and as many stitch holders as you have. Usually 5-6 is enough.

Additional suggestions- Bring a file folder with pockets; you can put your handout, notes and samples in the pockets. Everything will be organized.

Homework

Cast on 20 stitches. Work in garter stitch (knit every row) for 4 inches. For perfect edge stitches:

1 Knit into the back of the 1st stitch of every row and slip as if to purl, with the yarn in front, the last stitch of every row.

Leave stitches on the needle. Do not bind off.

Last but not least, bring your interest and enthusiasm to learn a new technique.
