Homework and Materials

Materials

Yarn- Bring the same yarn as your swatches and some smooth cotton yarn.

Needles-Bring the sizes you use with your yarn. Bring a tapestry needle with an eye large enough to use with your yarn.

Accessories- Bring your regular knitting accessories, including scissors.

Homework

In my experience it is far better to learn the techniques on swatches rather than on your sweater.

You will need to knit 6 small swatches: knit them in a D.K. or Worsted weight yarn in a light to medium color.

Three swatches as follows: CO 20sts.

Row 1. Knit.

Row 2. Purl.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 9 times more.

Two swatches as follows:

1. Cast on 20sts and work in garter stitch for 20 rows.

2. Knit 1 additional row on one of them

Leave the stitches on a holder or needle.

One swatch as follows:

Cast on 20sts.

Row 1. K1, P1

Row 2. K1 P1.

Repeat row 1 & 2 9 times more.

Please do all of the swatches, without swatches you cannot practice the techniques.

Learn the skills and techniques to showcase your knitting: go from homemade to handmade.
