

Knitted Beaded Bracelet Homework and Materials

This bracelet uses the finest metallic yarn/thread that I've ever seen, produced by On the Surface. It is only available at www.beadwrangler.com.

You may purchase the thread yourself, and pre-string the beads in any pattern. Be sure to have a clasp and size 00 or 000 double pointed knitting needles.

I will have kits for the bracelet for sale, for \$10.00. Colors are Black with accent color, copper/bronze with accent color, autumn colored bead soup mix with accent color and blue/blue-green colored bead soup mix with accent color. No two kits will be alike.

The kit includes:

1. 25 yards of the double stranded metallic thread on which I've pre-strung with beads in the pattern similar to the sample bracelet I designed.
2. A ball and socket clasp that matches or compliments the bracelet.
3. A needle for sewing on the clasp.
4. A pair of double pointed needles size 00 or 000.

Everyone will get a pattern and we'll discuss ideas for other bracelets.

I've pre-strung the bracelet because the class is 3 hours and stringing can take that long for the uninitiated.

The only homework is to practice knitting with the smallest needles you have to get your fingers use to the tiny size!

Be sure to bring your enthusiasm for a day of knitting a bracelet.
