

PATCHWORK KNITTING  
FINISHING; THE HORST SCHULZ WAY  
Homework and Materials

Materials

Yarn- Worsted, D.K., Novelty, and fingering weight yarn to coordinate with 1 or 2 of the colors you bring.

Needles- Appropriate for the yarn plus 1 to 2 sizes bigger and smaller.  
You will need circular, straight and double pointed needles.  
Be sure to bring the smallest circular needle you have, i.e. #1-3

Homework

Work two 6” square garter stitch swatches with perfect edge stitches (described below)  
Leave the stitches on the needle or a holder.

To create Perfect Edge Stitches:

Row 1. Knit into the back of the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, work next 9 stitches in seed stitch, and for the last stitch, slip as if to purl with the yarn in front.

Turn work.

Repeat row 1 for 5 inches and bind off. Make 2.

Last but not least bring your interest and enthusiasm.
