

Patchwork Knitting Strips Together Workshop

Homework and Materials

For you to learn and experience this exciting technique please bring the following:

SUPPLIES

YARN—your choice, worsted or D.K. Bring as many colors as you want, however 5-6 colors will suffice. From my experience, I suggest you bring the yarns you like to work with. The sample you create can serve as a model for further work.

NEEDLES-- sizes that work with your yarn. i.e. #4, 5 or 6 for D.K.
Either circular, straight or double-pointed will do.

ACCESSORIES—Scissors, tape measure, pencil, yarn needle, calculator, stitch holders.

HOMEWORK

1. Measure a favorite vest as follows:
 - A. Length
 - B. Width
 - C. Armhole depth
 - D. Shoulder to shoulder
 - E. Back of neck (1/3 of shoulder to shoulder)

If you don't have a vest to measure, I'll have the measurements for a child's size 4 vest.

2. Knit a sample as follows:
Cast on 11 stitches.

Row 1 Knit into the back of the 1st stitch, work next 9 stitches in seed stitch, and for the last stitch, slip as if to purl with the yarn in front.

Turn work. Repeat row 1 for 5 inches and bind off. Make 2.

Last but not least, bring your curiosity and enthusiasm.
