

STUCK ON STEEKS ??

Homework and materials

For you to learn and experience these exciting techniques please bring the following:

Materials

Yarn—bring a fingering weight yarn i.e. sock yarn in a contrasting color to the swatch

Bring your swatch yarn and a contrasting color of yarn that is the same weight.

Knitting Needles- sizes that work with your yarn and needles 3-4 sizes smaller.

Crochet hooks-C or D for DK weight yarn, F or G for worsted weight.

ACCESSORIES—Bring your usual supplies plus a large scissor.

Homework- cannot experience class without swatch.

To make is easy we will work our sample flat.

Cast on 50sts.

Row 1. K10, Knit into the back of the next 4sts, K36

Row 2. P36, Purl into the back of the next 4sts, P10.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for a total of 20 rows.

For purists you may work 3 swatches in the round, be sure to have one with the Knit into the back of the next 4sts section.
