

Short Row Socks on Two Circular Needles Workshop

Materials

To learn the technique, we will all work with sock/fingering yarn and two 24 inch circular knitting needles.

Yarn- Bring traditional sock yarn.

Or fingering yarns such as, “Jitterbug” by Colinette,

“Soxie” by Great Adirondack Yarns,

Ultramarine 4 by Artyarns, or

Claudia handpainted, are suitable yarns. Be sure to purchase these yarns prior to class as they are put up in skeins and need to be made into a ball to start knitting.

Needles- Two 24 inch circular needles, size 1.

Additional suggestions- Bring a file folder with pockets; you can put your handout and notes in the pockets. Everything will be organized.

Bring a tapestry needle to work the Kitchener stitch.

Last but not least, bring your interest and enthusiasm to learn a new technique.
